



BANGLADESH IN UN PEACEKEEPING

Bangladesh is pledge-bound to the principles enshrined in the United Nations Charter, the peaceful settlement of international disputes and to the maintenance of global peace and security. The roadmap of Bangladesh for affiliation with world peace is firmly pronounced in the constitution of the country. Steadfastly inherent to this national commitment, Bangladesh Armed Forces have globally been engaged in the United Nations Peacekeeping Operations (UNPKO) around the globe for more than several decades. Footprints of Bangladeshi peacekeepers are now evident in almost all of the troubled areas of the world, starting from Lebanon to DR Congo and many more. The peacekeepers of Bangladesh have been almost everywhere and are committed to remain devoted to their noble cause. Today, Bangladeshi peacekeepers have rightfully earned the credentials of 'Role Model' in global peacekeeping due to their professionalism, commitment, impartiality, integrity and humane attitude.

Bangladesh stepped into the family of "Blue Helmet" through participation in UNIIMOG (Irag-Iran) in 1988 with 15 military Observers from Bangladesh Army. Bangladesh Navy and Bangladesh Air Force joined UNPKO in 1993, while Bangladesh Police joined in 1989. As of yet, Bangladesh has contributed in 54 out of total 68 UN peacekeeping missions where 1,44,739 Bangladeshi peacekeepers have participated. Presently, with a strength of 7,200 peacekeepers, Bangladesh is one of the highest ranking peacekeepers contributing country in the world. Bangladeshi peacekeepers have been operating in many of the beleaquered areas of the world, under different type of situations and even amidst life threatening circumstances. On the way to achieving global peace, 130 Bangladeshi brave and valiant sons have laid down their lives with supreme sacrifice. We all salute the supreme sacrifices made by these true sons of peace. Bangladesh resolutely reiterates her firm commitment to undertake any UN assignment for global peace and stability at all time.
